## COMPUTER USE AGREEMENT AT SCHOOL FOR BYOD

Senior students who wish to bring their own devices to Waikerie High School must read the following document with their parent/s or guardian/s and understand conditions within.

Senior students at this stage are the only students able to bring their personal device to Waikerie High School due to the school's network capacity and its capabilities.

Things to consider:

1. The device is used for education purpose while at Waikerie High School.
2. The device will only be able to be joined to the schools' internet through a set of instructions supplied by Waikerie High School and students do so at their own risk.
3. The device cannot join Waikerie High Schools' domain network due to security associated with the network, as the school will not compromise the integrity of its network environment.
4. Having a device not joined to the schools' domain network – students will not have access the school's file repository. Students must rely on employing some form of external backup system of their device in case of hardware or software failures of the device. Failure to have a backup of work may result in a non-submission of an assignment
5. Students must source their own software as per requirements of what is required to complete their education.
6. The device must have its own anti-virus protection software installed.  
**Virus Software Applications include:** AVG, Avast, Spybot, Windows Defender, McAfee, Norton.
7. Students will need to back up their own data.
8. From time to time, it may be necessary to monitor the activity of the device at Waikerie High School.
9. Students will need to follow the ICT Device Policy. Any device used in any inappropriate means within the school will be removed from the student and be placed at the front office for a parent or guardian to collect, as per the schools' device policy. If severe enough, the student will not be able to return to school with that device.
10. The school will not take any responsibility of the device in regards to its security, care, repairs, maintenance, hardware or software associated with the device.
11. The school will not take responsibility for lost, stolen or damaged laptops and cannot commit to unnecessary resources to resolve these issues.
12. Any software or hardware issues to do with the device, students will need to contact place of purchase or manufacturer themselves to resolve these issues.
13. All devices need to be charged at home. Due to OHS, students will not be able to charge their devices on school premises.
14. Students will have access to the internet and print facilities at the school and will require them download software for this to occur. Students will be charged at normal rates for printing and internet. An appointment needs to be made with the IT Technician for this to take place. Students need to load this software on the device themselves at their own risk.
15. I have downloaded the Computer Use Agreement booklet and have read it with my parents/caregivers.
